IN MEMORIAM STANLEY B. ROSENFIELD

The death of Prof. Stanley B. Rosenfield, L L.B., L L.M., S.J.D., on 2 January 1985, who regularly contributed to *Air Law*, will be widely regretted by the many international lawyers who knew him well as colleague and as a good and reliable friend.

After getting his degrees at the University of Minnesota and the Southern Methodist University Professor Rosenfield had a private practice of law and acted also as vice-president and general counsel to manufacturers.

After 1969 Professor Rosenfield entered the teaching profession, first as an assistant-professor of law at De Paul University Law School in Chicago but soon as a Professor of Law at the New England School of Law in Boston.

From 1980-1982 Professor Rosenfield was Faculty Fellow United States Department of Transportation, Washington D.C. International law, transportation law, environmental law and air and space law had his great interest.

Many books and other publications are the product of his solid study in these branches.

Moreover, Professor Rosenfield was very active in several Associations, among others the American Bar Association, the International Law Association, the American Society of International Law, the International Institute of Space Law and the World Professors Association of the World Peace Through Law.

But Professor Rosenfield was not only held in high esteem by his students and colleagues because of his profound scientific knowledge but also by his integrity and pleasant personality.

We miss him but everyone who had the privilege of knowing him will honour his memory.
