COMMON MARKET LAW REVIEW PRIZE FOR YOUNG ACADEMICS 2024

The Editorial Board is pleased to announce the 2024 Common Market Law Review Prize for Young Academics.

Submissions for the Prize may be on any subject in the area of European Union law, written by a young or early career academic. The maximum wordcount is 10,000 words, including footnotes.

The Editorial Board will be looking for originality of thought, a significant contribution to existing scholarship, quality of analysis and research, and excellence in presentation.

There will be a monetary prize of 500 euros, and the winning article will be published in Common Market Law Review.

In order to qualify as a young or early career academic, authors should in principle be aged 30 or under. Authors over the age of 30 are eligible if it is less than three years since they completed their PhD. Co-authored articles are admissible, provided both authors are young or early career academics. Parental leave or other significant caring responsibilities may be taken into account when establishing eligibility.

The submission deadline is 15 October 2024.
