EC Tax Review: the grown up kangaroo

From the Spring of 1992 onwards the EC Tax Review has lived in close symbiosis with Intertax. Like a young kangaroo it was pleasantly hopping along with its big mother, who had helped to launch it. Time has come to separate, because the kangaroo has grown up. With the first issue of 2007 we celebrate the fifteenth anniversary of the EC Tax Review. On this occasion the publisher has taken the fortunate decision to separate the two reviews and at the same time to increase its frequency to six issues per year, so that it will effectively become a bi-monthly journal.

Several factors have played a role in this decision: (1) the increasing demand from the readers for a separate review, (2) the avalanche of recent decisions by the ECJ and as a result (3) the growing flow of articles from an increasing number of authors and (4) the sense that increasing the frequency of the review and decreasing somewhat its volume per issue would

enhance the standing of the journal with its readership.

This important decision also means more work for the Editorial Board. Therefore we have also decided to reduce the number of Members of the Board to persons effectively involved in the redaction of each single issue. At the same time we have established an Advisory Board of experts in European and International Taxation which we will consult from time to time on all issues related to the well-being of the journal. Our network of correspondents will also be reviewed, but its structure remains unchanged. Finally and for the time being, the general format of the journal will remain unchanged.
