94/204/EC, Euratom, Commission Decision of 16 March 1994 on the creation of the European Science and Technology Assembly (OJ 1994 L93/34). This Decision sets up a consultative committee to advise the Commission. The essential task of the Assembly is to help the Commission to prepare, implement and monitor Community policy in research and technological development.

94/217/EC, Council Decision of 19 April on the provision of Community interest subsidies on loans for small and medium-sized enterprises extended by the

European Investment Bank under its temporary lending facility (OJ 1994 L107/57). There will be a note on this in the July *Eurobrief*.

Council Statement concerning Article 7(4) of Council Directive 93/37/EEC (OJ 1993 L199/54) of 14 June 1993 concerning the coordination of procedure for the award of public works contracts (OJ 1994 L111/114). The statement is set out below.

"STATEMENT CONCERNING ARTICLE 7(4) [and ARTICLE 20 below]

The Council and the Commission state that in open and restricted procedures all negotiations with candidates or tenderers on fundamental aspects of contracts, variations in which are likely to distort competition, and in particular on prices, shall be ruled out; however, discussions with candidates or tenderers may be held but only for the purpose of clarifying or supplementing the

content of their tenders or the requirements of the contracting authorities and provided this does not involve discrimination."

The College is to meet once a week with additional meetings when necessary. The meetings are not to be public and deliberations are to remain confidential. The Rules are authentic in English.
